The Board of County Commissioners now meets pursuant to adjournment.

Present: Keith Goodwin Chairman Jim Baldwin Member Amy White-Tanabe Administrator Lyn Scott Clerk

Guests in attendance were: Jolly Rose, Marty Lee, Danelle Berg, Darren Garcia, Lex Nichols, Anne Boswell, Christian Burney.

Chr. Goodwin called the meeting to order and to approve the minutes from January 6th, 2020. Co. Baldwin motioned to approve the minutes. Chr. Goodwin seconded. Motion carried.

Darren Garcia presented the Weed Spraying Bid for \$19,660.00 for Mix A, noxious weeds at \$35.00 per acre and Johnson grass at \$50.00 per acre. A copy of the total bid is included. Discussion was held. Co. Baldwin motioned to approve the bid. Chr. Goodwin seconded. Motion carried.

County Treasurer Dennis Smith presented the Public Trustee report for 3rd and 4th quarter of 2019. For the 3rd quarter there were 104 releases and 11 new foreclosures. In the 4th quarter there were 137 releases and 11 new foreclosures. Discussion was held.

Danelle Berg reported that South East Council of Governments is putting out the annual DOLA mini-grant applications are available. These are \$10,000.00 grants and are considered a match grant, meaning that they will give \$5,000.00 to a match of the recipient of \$5,000.00. This year there will be 3 projects per County, if needed. The applications need to be turned in by the 19th of February. Last week she attended a Neighbor Works Review lunch meeting held by Total Concepts. She felt that the meeting was informative. Ms. Berg attended a Southeast Colorado Economic Development District meeting. Chaffee and Custer Counties had new members attend the meeting. Pueblo County appointed 2 new members from outside of government that will open up new perspectives. She is working on the year end reports for DOLA and for CDBG. Discussion was held.

Admin. White-Tanabe shared that she met with Gallagher to discuss the county health insurance. A wellness committee is being planned as is a wellness program. She met with PCD Engineering on the new generator for the Sheriff's Office. The Colorado Health Foundation sent a donation of \$25,000.00 for Census marketing, this will be used to get information out on the Census.

Co. Baldwin reported that the attended a STAC meeting. There will be a project starting soon between Manzanola and Fowler putting in a passing lane. Co. Baldwin also attended the Arkansas Basin Roundtable meeting. The gentleman who created the roundtable Russ George was there and answered questions on the history of the roundtable. It was a good meeting. There is 7.7 million dollars available as grants through the CWCB for projects and applications are now being taken. Discussion was held.

Chr. Goodwin shared that along with the other Crowley and Bent County Commissioners in the 16th Judicial District, met to discuss a memorandum of understanding on how the budget works with the District Attorney's Office. They also discussed the renovation of the District Attorney's office building.

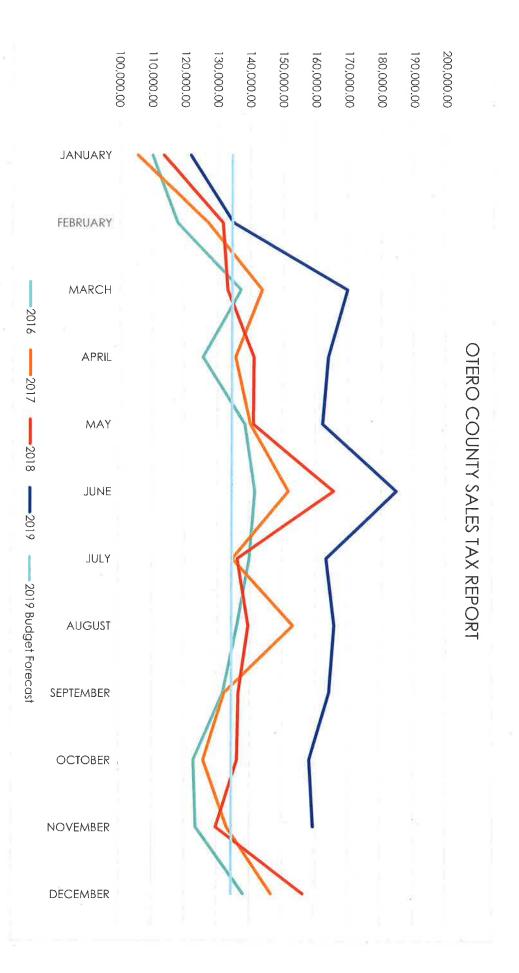
