Guests in attendance via phone/zoom: Adrian Hart, Marty Lee, and Anne Boswell. In Person: Danelle Berg, Jennifer Rife, and Jolly Rose.

Chr. Baldwin called the meeting to order and asked for approval of the minutes from February 22, 2021. Co. Oquist motioned to approve the minutes. Co. Hostetler seconded. Motion carried.

Admin. White-Tanabe presented Resolution 2021-04 A Resolution Recognizing the Many Past and Current Contributions of Otero County Cattlemen and Other Livestock Producers and Supporting the Local Ranching Industry. Admin. White-Tanabe said this was in protest to the Meat Out day that Governor Polis declared for March 20th, 2021, and it was written in the spirit that the government should not attack any industry in the state. A copy of the Resolution is attached. Co. Hostetler motioned to approve the resolution. Co. Oquist seconded. Motion carried.

Admin. White-Tanabe presented the bills for February 1st to February 15th, 2021. Admin. White-Tanabe thanked Danelle Berg for her hard work getting the small business relief monies out to the business that needed it. Co. Oquist motioned to approve the bills. Co. Hostetler seconded. Motion carried.

Danelle Berg reported that the Otero Junior College is making some changes so her office will now be at the Annex in Rocky Ford. She is happy that the small business grant is being looked at by the legislature to make the requirements a little less strict so that businesses can get help. OPI is doing well, and they are getting a lot of request for small business loans. SEBREA is championing support letters to the legislature for the Meat Out and for the redistricting committee to get support for Southern Colorado to make sure that we are represented. SCEDD has been working on economic development for forprofit and non-profit businesses, and all entities that wish to participate. There will be two meetings in April to talk about what is working, what is not, and to look at projects that they may want to develop.

Admin. White-Tanabe introduced Jennifer Rife to everyone. She is the new administrative assistant to the Commissioner's.

Co. Hostetler reported that he met with CDOT on the bridge replacement on Highway 71. It is coming along well. He spent time on the CCI calls reviewing legislation.

Co. Oquist reported that he visited the CSU Extension office. He was not aware of how much involvement the CSU office gives to the 4-H programs. He also toured the Dispatch Center in Yuma, with Undersheriff Matt Wallace and the dispatch supervisors from Rocky Ford and La Junta. Yuma has a three-county dispatch center that the County would like to investigate implementing..

With no further business, the board adjourned the meeting.
