Guests in attendance were: on phone: Donna Rohde, Christian Burney, Danelle Berg, Pat McGee and Marty Lee. In person: Rick Ritter.

Chr. Goodwin called the meeting to order and requested approval of the minutes from April 6, 2020 with the following correction, next meeting reads April 6<sup>th,</sup> it should have read next meeting April 13<sup>th</sup>. Co. Baldwin motioned to approve the minutes. Co. Hostetler seconded. Motion carried.

Admin. White-Tanabe presented the Bid Award for the Emergency Generator Project for the Sheriff's Dept. The winning bid goes to Valley View Electric for \$86,472.00 which should be under budget. Co. Hostetler motioned to approve the bid. Co. Baldwin seconded. Motion carried.

Admin. White-Tanabe presented bids for a Staff Evaluation Study. This is to upgrade the personnel forms and make the process more modern, so we can be more positive and help pinpoint areas of improvement. There were 3 bids received they are as follows: 1) Zilo International Group for \$68,000.00; 2) Evergreen Solutions LLC for \$42,000.00 and 3) CPS HR Consulting for \$15,525.00. Admin White-Tanabe asked for 2 weeks to review and recommend a winning bid. Co. Baldwin motioned to approve the review. Co. Hostetler seconded. Motion carried.

Rick Ritter, Director of the Health Department gave an update on the COVID-19 situation. There was a new case on Friday, in Crowley County, in their 40's and already in recovery. At this point we have 7 cases, 2 in Crowley County and 5 in Otero. As of 4/12, there were 7303 cases, 1417 hospitalized, 37,153 people tested, 290 deaths and 56 Counties in the State of Colorado. We are at this time not seeing clusters of cases resulting from one positive case.

Chr. Goodwin reported that he is glad to see the volunteerism from everyone within the community. He talked a little about the fire at Bent's Old Fort and wanted to thank the volunteers that worked the fire. Co. Hostetler stated that County Rd 21 is now open the bridge project is completed.

With no further business, the board adjourned the meeting.

### AMENDED/RESTATED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT OF OTERO PARTNERS, INCORPORATED

THIS INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT is made, executed and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2020, by and between the following parties:

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Otero County, Colorado, a body politic and corporate, hereinafter referred to as "Otero County";

2. The City of La Junta, a home rule municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "La Junta";

3. The City of Rocky Ford, a statutory municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Rocky Ford";

4. The Town of Cheraw, a statutory municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Cheraw";

5. The Town of Swink, a statutory municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Swink";

6. The Town of Manzanola, a statutory municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Manzanola";

7. The Town of Fowler, a statutory municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Fowler";

8. The Board of County Commissioners of Las Animas County, Colorado, a body politic and corporate, hereinafter referred to as "Las Animas County"

all of whom understand as follows:

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on September 26, 2001, Articles of Incorporation were filed with the Colorado Secretary of State's Office to establish a non-profit corporation known as "Otero Partners, Incorporated" (sometimes hereinafter referred to as "OPI" or the "Entity"); and

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2002, an Intergovernmental Agreement was entered into among the above-named parties in which the parties agreed to form and utilize an entity to organize, develop, establish, operate and administer a revolving loan fund to encourage economic diversification and job creation and retention to benefit very low, low and moderate income persons in Otero County, Colorado, and Las Animas County, Colorado; and

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WHEREAS, Otero Partners, Incorporated, is desirous of expanding its services and activities to provide citizen services by serving as a building facilities manager and overseeing rental of commercial spaces in Otero and Las Animas Counties; and

WHEREAS, Section Two, paragraph 5, of the Intergovernmental Agreement provides that the Intergovernmental Agreement may be modified or amended only upon execution of such an amendment done in writing and executed and agreed upon by all of the parties hereto; and

WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of amending said Intergovernmental Agreement and reducing said amendment to writing.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

#### SECTION ONE

#### **GENERAL PROVISIONS**

The parties hereto hereby support, authorize and direct said legal entity to operate and administer a revolving loan fund within Otero County, Colorado, and Las Animas County, Colorado, and hereby further support, authorize and direct said legal entity to serve as a building facilities manager to oversee rental of commercial spaces in Otero and Las Animas Counties, which separate legal entity shall sometimes be hereinafter referred to as the "Entity".

The parties hereto stipulate and agree that said parties may by resolution or ordinance constitute, authorize and empower the Entity on behalf of each party hereto with full power to enter into contracts, to sue and be sued, and otherwise to do all things necessary to carry out the duties and obligations delegated and agreed to hereunder and to further operate and administer a revolving loan fund and to further serve as a building facilities manager in Otero County and Las Animas County, Colorado.

#### SECTION TWO

#### **ORGANIZATION AND OPERATION OF THE ENTITY**

1. The Entity's governing board shall be comprised of one elected official or designee from each of the following entities:

- (a) Board of County Commissioners of Otero County, Colorado;
- (b) City of La Junta, Colorado;
- (c) City of Rocky Ford, Colorado

- (d) Town of Cheraw, Colorado;
- (e) Town of Swink, Colorado;
- (f) Town of Manzanola, Colorado;
- (g) Town of Fowler, Colorado
- (h) Board of County Commissioners of Las Animas County, Colorado

2. The Entity may contract with any public or private organization for services and/or employees.

3. The Entity shall maintain adequate and correct accounts of their funds, properties and business transactions, which funds, properties and business transactions shall be open to inspection at all reasonable times by the parties hereto, their attorneys and/or their agents.

4. The Board of Directors of the Entity, its officers and employees, shall not be personally liable for any acts performed or omitted in good faith. The parties hereto shall indemnify and hold harmless the Entity, its members, officers, and employees from claims or judgments of third parties resulting from acts or omissions attributable to the good faith performance and the work for or of the Entity. The Entity may purchase insurance to provide coverage for the governing board members, officers, and employees and the Entity against suit or suits which may be brought against said members of the board, officers and employees, or the Entity itself involving or pertaining to any of their acts or duties performed or omitted by the Entity in good faith.

5. This Intergovernmental Agreement may be modified or amended only upon execution of such an amendment done in writing and executed and agreed upon by all of the parties hereto.

6. The parties shall utilize a loan committee to review and make recommendations concerning loans to applicants except when the applicant is utilizing the MICRO Loan Policy as set forth hereafter. The loan committee shall consist of seven members, four of which shall be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of Otero County, Colorado, plus one alternate, three of which shall be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of Las Animas County, Colorado, plus one alternate. The loan committee shall meet as needed and arranged to make recommendations on pending loan applications. Recommendations shall be made by a majority vote of a quorum, and a quorum shall consist of four members. The designated alternate may act as a voting member of the loan committee only upon the absence of a designated member for whom the alternate has been appointed. The Board of Directors of OPI shall make the final decision concerning loans to applicants after receiving the recommendations of the loan committee.

In the event an applicant chooses to utilize the MICRO Loan Policy previously approved by the OPI Board of Directors, the review of the application and eventual decision shall be made by the OPI Chairperson and Secretary/Treasurer in that the MICRO Loan Policy is for the purpose of providing a loan to businesses in need of a small, immediate cash injection to maintain their livelihood and is an expedited process. In the event the Chairperson or Secretary/Treasurer are not available, the Vice Chairperson may be utilized in the review and decision-making process.

7. Otero Partners, Incorporated, through its Board of Directors, or the Board's designee, may serve as a building facilities manager and oversee rental of commercial spaces within Otero and Las Animas Counties. The duties of OPI as a building facilities manager shall be set forth in each agreement between OPI and the commercial building owner.

#### SECTION THREE

#### TERM

The term of this agreement shall be perpetual.

#### **SECTION FOUR**

#### WAIVER OF IMMUNITIES

The parties, by executing this agreement, do not waive any of the duties, privileges, immunities, rights, and limitations of liabilities that such parties have as a corporate body, governmental entity, or political subdivision of the state or as a quasimunicipal corporation as the case may be, and to the extent permitted by law, these duties, privileges, rights and limitations of liabilities shall extend to and be binding upon the Entity.

#### SECTION FIVE

#### **SEVERABILITY**

If any provision of this agreement or the application hereof to any party or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or application of this agreement which can be given without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end, the provisions of this agreement are declared to be severable.

This Agreement may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have executed this agreement the day and year first above written.
