AMENDMENT TO PROGRAMMATIC AGREEMENT BETWEEN BUREAU OF RECLAMATION, EASTERN COLORADO AREA OFFICE, AND THE COLORADO STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER REGARDINGING THE ARKANSAS VALLEY CONDUIT PROJECT, COLORADO

WHEREAS, on July 31, 2013, the Bureau of Reclamation Eastern Colorado Area Office (ECAO) and the Colorado State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) executed a Programmatic Agreement (Agreement) pursuant to the regulations implementing Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (54 U.S.C. 306108) regarding historic properties potentially affected by the construction of the Arkansas Valley Conduit Project (Undertaking) and;

WHEREAS, the Agreement is currently set to expire on July 31, 2023 and the signatories have agreed to extend the terms of the Agreement pursuant to Stipulation X of the Agreement for an additional ten (10) years in order to continue a phased process to identify historic properties [36 CFR 800.4(b)(2)] and assess the effects on those properties [36 CFR 800.5(a)(3)]; such that completion of the identification and evaluation of historic properties, determinations of effect on historic properties, and consultation concerning measures to avoid, minimize, or mitigate any adverse effects will be carried out in phases as part of the planning for and prior to implementation of the Undertaking; and

WHEREAS, ECAO will send a copy of this executed amendment to all signatories;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation X of the Agreement, ECAO and Colorado SHPO agree to amend this Agreement as follows:

1. Amend Stipulation VIII so it reads as follows: This agreement shall be extended for a period of ten (10) years from the date of the last signature on this Amendment.
