Chr. Goodwin called the meeting to order and requested approval of the minutes from June 29th, 2020. Co. Baldwin motioned to approve the minutes. Co. Hostetler seconded. Motion carried.

Chr. Goodwin called for approval of the bills from June 16th to June 30th. Co. Hostetler motioned to approve the bills. Co. Baldwin seconded. Motion carried.

Admin. White-Tanabe on behalf of the Rocky Ford Fire Department presented 2 ambulance permits. They retired the Med 3 Ambulance and made Med 2, Med 3. They now have a 2020 Dodge that is now Med 2. She would like signature on the permits. Co. Baldwin motioned to approve the permits. Co. Hostetler seconded. Motion carried.

Danelle Berg reported that she is working on 2 loans, one is ready to go, and the other one is still needing documents. These are for CDBG grants. The Las Animas Commissioner Luis Lopez has been sending people to Ms. Berg for loans. She also met with the Peer Group Exchange, the group is made up of urban and rural people they discuss issues facing communities and the struggle with the pandemic. They have started a Kind Campaign. The group is also working on mental health and what to do to help the shut-ins and people in nursing homes and the like. They talked about having youth groups write letters and send things to the homes to reach out to the residents.

Clerk Scott said that the election went well. No major problems.

Admin. White-Tanabe shared that she is kicking off the 2021 preliminary budgeting process.

Co. Baldwin shared that he listened to the Gallagher Amendment legislation and has nothing new to report on that.

Co. Hostetler attended a Zoom meeting on the opioid crisis. He attended the memorial service for Chris Johnson. He also helped put out flags for the 4th in La Junta and Swink.

Chr. Goodwin also attended the Zoom meeting on the opioid crisis, the attorney general for the State wants all of the Counties to join with the State for the class-action suit. Several counties have filed on their own, as they did not want a repeat of the tobacco lawsuit, where the State received most of the monies.

MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT FOR WILDFIRE RESPONSE SERVICES

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 26th day of May , 2020, by and between Otero County, Colorado ("County") and the City of Rocky Ford ("Rocky Ford"), who hereby establish an Agreement for assistance as it pertains to wildfire response in each respective jurisdictional boundary.

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes 29-1-203 authorizes governmental entities to contract with one another to provide any function, service, or facility lawfully authorized to each of the cooperating entities; and

WHEREAS, it is and will continue to be of mutual benefit to the City of Rocky Ford and Otero County to assist in providing additional equipment and personnel for the purpose of delivering wildfire response services within their respective boundaries;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants, performances and agreements hereafter set forth, it is mutually understood and agreed between the City of Rocky Ford and Otero County as follows:

A. DEFINITIONS:

- a. Answering Agency: The agency responding to a request within the boundaries of the Requesting Agency.
- b. Requesting Agency: The agency asking for aid under this agreement.
- c. Coordinator: The person responsible for the respective agency or his/her authorized representative.
- d. Incident Commander: The Requesting Agency shall be the Incident Commander until such authority is delegated as allowed by law.
- B. MUTUAL ASSISTANCE AND AID: Rocky Ford and the County agree to mutually respond to requests for assistance as it pertains to wildfire response when circumstances allow for response. The Coordinator for the Answering Agency will determine the level of personnel and equipment that can be provided in each particular situation. The level of personnel and equipment that will be provided is at the sole discretion of the Answering Agency, and it is acknowledged that in certain circumstances, the Answering Agency may not be able to provide any response under this Agreement.
- C. RESPONSE (INITIAL ATTACK FIRST 8 HOURS): When circumstances allow, Rocky Ford and the County agree that they will provide wildfire response assistance to and within the Requesting Agency's jurisdiction when such assistance is requested. The Answering Agency will provide assistance for eight

- (8) hours, if possible and necessary, subject to the terms of paragraph B above, without charge to the Requesting Agency with the exception of the following expenses:
- a. Fuel: The Requesting Agency shall pay for the Answering Agency's fuel.
- b. Food: The Requesting Agency shall pay for food for the Answering Agency's personnel.
- c. Tires: The Requesting Agency shall pay for the Answering Agency's tires, if necessary.
- D. RESPONSE (EXTENDED ATTACK MORE THAN 8 HOURS): Upon mutual agreement of Rocky Ford and the County at the time of the wildfire, the Answering Agency may continue to provide assistance beyond eight (8) hours. The Requesting Agency shall not pay for any expenses of the Answering Agency beyond the eight (8) hours unless the Coordinators for the Agencies agree to the continued assistance of the Answering Agency beyond the initial eight (8) hours.
- E. RESPONSIBILITY/LIABILITY AS TO THE AGENCY'S PERSONNEL AND EQUIPMENT: Each individual Agency shall assume full and complete responsibility and liability for its own personnel and equipment during any and all response incidents.
- F. SUPERVISION: Any personnel of the Answering Agency who is assigned or requested to provide assistance shall, for such purposes only, be under the direction and control of the Incident Commander. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the Answering Agency shall have the right to refuse to perform, or refuse to allow any of its personnel to perform requested acts or services when it deems such acts or services to be inappropriate under the circumstances, and shall follow the National Incident Management System, such determination to be at the sole discretion of the Answering Agency.
- G. INDEMNIFICATION: Each Agency shall indemnify, defend against, and save the other Agency, including its officers, agents, and personnel, harmless from any and all demands, claims, losses, liabilities, and costs incurred by third parties for damages to person(s) or property which may arise out of or result directly or indirectly from providing mutual aid and assistance under this Agreement, to the extent permitted by law.
- H. IMMUNITY: The assistance authorized pursuant to this Agreement shall be deemed for public and governmental purposes. All immunities from liability available to the Agencies, including their officers, agents, and personnel, shall extend to each Agency's participation in rendering mutual aid and assistance under this Agreement. Nothing herein shall be construed or is intended to waive any such immunity, unless otherwise provided by law. All exemptions or

defenses from any taws or ordinances available to the Requesting Agency shall be deemed available to the Answering Agency and its personnel and agents.

- I. WAIVER: Each Agency waives any and all claims against the other Agency and its officers, agents, and personnel, which may arise while lawfully rendering mutual aid and assistance pursuant to this Agreement, except where such claim arises out of gross negligence, reckless, or wanton and willful misconduct attributable to the other Agency's personnel, and to the extent permitted under the subrogation provisions of applicable insurance policies. Nothing contained in this provision waives any claims, rights, or obligations that arise from this Agreement.
- J. EFFECTIVE DATE/TERMINATION: This Agreement shall become effective upon the approval and signature by the authorized representative of the Agencies hereto and shall continue until such time as any one Agency submits to the other a sixty (60) day written notice of the intention to terminate this Agreement.
- K. NON-ASSIGNABILITY: This Agreement is non-assignable by either Agency.
- L. INTERPRETATION/ENFORCEMENT: This Agreement shall be interpreted and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Colorado.
- M. MODIFICATION: No change or modification to the terms of this Agreement shall be valid unless the same is made in writing and signed by both parties.
- N. ENTIRE AGREEMENT: This Agreement as set forth contains the entire agreement of the Agencies, and there are no other responsibilities, covenants, promises or conditions set forth by any other agreement, oral or written.
- O. TERMINATION OF PREVIOUS MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT. That the Mutual Aid Agreement for Wildfire Response Services entered into between Otero County, Colorado, and The Rocky Ford Rural Fire Protection District and signed by the City of Rocky Ford dated November 21, 2016, is terminated as of the date of the signing of this Agreement.
