Chr. Oquist asked everyone to stand for prayer and to recite the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chr. Oquist called the regular meeting to order.

Dr. JC Carrica was present and invited everyone to the new Grand Re-opening coming up in Rocky Ford for the new Valley Wide Health Clinic after completing a remodel. The new map proposal is called the ACC3.0 for accountable care, also known as Regional Accountable Entity, The Ray Regions. We are getting ready to have our 3rd edition of model in July 2025. Everyone should have a map showing the current East to West version. The map doesn't capture accurately the way the patients flow. Medicaid utilization is finding more patient flow West, and not kept here local in the Valley or going North. People are going to Pueblo or Colorado Springs, whether they are Medicaid or private insurance holders, if they cannot receive the health care and the resources they need. With many other stake holders, we can work together to propose a North to South map to follow patient flows across the State instead of East to West. Our demographics and economic conditions look similar to the San Luis Valley. Dropping from 7 Regions to 4 is to address more lives in sharing the behavioral health risk. The State, by going to 4 regions, makes sense as Health insurance companies will bid on those regions because they feel they can better manage the risk. Jodi Kern, Rio Grande Mineral combined director, is gathering the names of those who are in support of the proposed model. One letter will be issued with all supporting entities for the map. The map region has changed 4 times in the last 7 to 8 months.

Chr. Oquist called for approval of the consent agenda. The agenda includes approval of the minutes from July 24th, 2023, and bills and payroll for July 16th, 2023 - July 31st, 2023. Co. Baldwin motioned to approve the consent agenda. Co. Knabenshue seconded. Motion carries.

Veronica Mata, Deputy Clerk, presented renewal of liquor license for La Junta Golf Course/The Fairway. Co. Knabenshue motioned to approve Liquor License renewal for La Junta Golf Course/The Fairway. Co. Baldwin seconded. Motion carries.

Veronica Mata, Deputy Clerk, presented renewal of liquor license for Felisa's Mexican Restaurant. Co. Baldwin motioned to approve Liquor License renewal for Felisa's Mexican Restaurant. Co. Knabenshue seconded. Motion carries.

Veronica Mata, Deputy Clerk, presented a request for approval of Danny Boy Foundation liquor license for (1) day event. Co. Knabenshue motioned to approve Danny Boy Foundation Liquor License. Co. Baldwin seconded. Motion carries.

Admin. White-Tanabe talked about Resolution 2023-010, the revision of the Commissioner Districts map. This is reevaluated when a census is completed. Otero County did not have much of a change in census numbers. There is no reason to adjust the districts currently. Co. Knabenshue motioned to approve Resolution 2023-010 Authorizing Revision of Commissioner Districts. Co. Baldwin seconded. Motion carries.

Admin. White-Tanabe is working on Detention development as well as the new Sheriff's Administration Building and it looks like we are closer to final blueprints and design. She also notified that a Grant previously applied for to assist with the new build was approved for \$1,000,000.00 from DOLA. She also talked about the budget.

Co. Baldwin had a round table meeting. Not much new.

Co. Knabenshue along with Co. Baldwin thanked Admin. White-Tanabe on the Grant approval to assist with the Detention and Sherrif Administration build. Co. Knabenshue attended Regional Healthcare. He also attended the Board of Healthcare Meeting with discussion of Opioid problems. He attended TPR and economic development and housing availability.

Chr. Oquist spoke about several meetings he attended. Chr. Oquist expressed how great it is to see the accomplishments and development of plans moving along for the new jail. He's had some CCI meetings to get ready for Legislative issues. He spoke about meeting with SECORE, Region 9 opioid abuse, and the money received from the federal government due to lawsuits. It's interesting to see how much we are getting done with this money.

With no further business the Board adjourned the meeting.

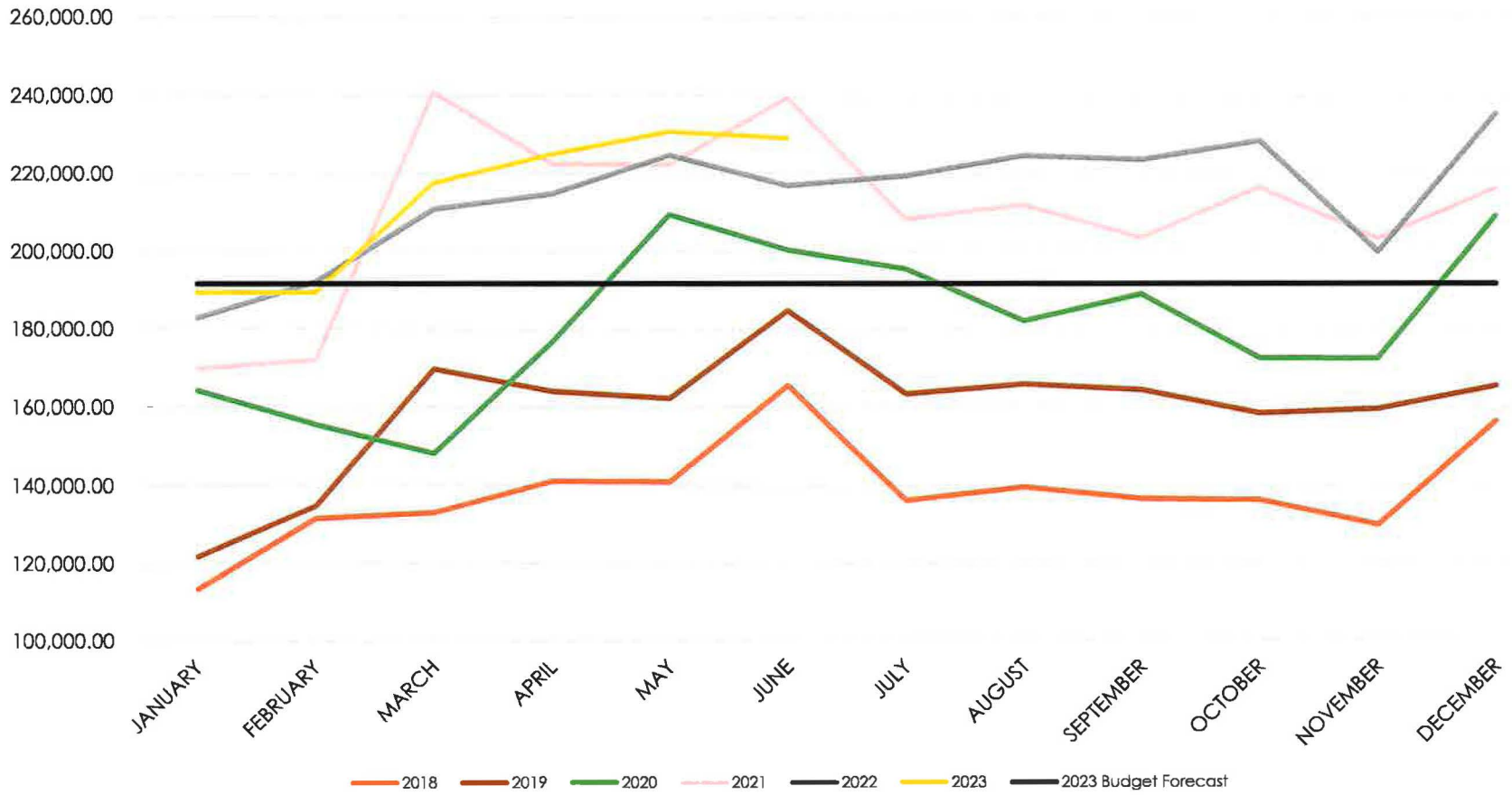
