Resolution #2024-15

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING RULES FOR PUBLIC RECORD REQUESTS AND IMPOSING A FEE FOR THE RESEARCH AND RETRIEVAL OF PUBLIC RECORDS

WHEREAS, C.R.S. §24-72-203(1)(a) permits Otero County to make such rules with reference to the inspection of public records and the prevention of unnecessary interference with the regular discharge of the duties of the custodian or the custodian's office; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. §24-72-205(6)(a) permits Otero County to impose a fee in response to a request for the research and retrieval of public records; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. §24-72-205(6)(a) requires Otero County to publish a written policy that specifies the applicable conditions concerning the research and retrieval of public records by the custodian; and

WHEREAS, Otero County desires to impose a fee for the retrieval and research of public records.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Otero, Colorado, pursuant to the Colorado Redistricting Commissions, that:

- 1. All requests for public records shall be on the form developed and maintained by the County of Otero's Clerk and Recorder's Office.
 - 2. After the first hour of time has been expended researching and/or retrieving public records, Otero County shall charge a fee.

- 3. The current fee shall be \$41.37 per hour but shall automatically increase every five-year period to be equal with the rate adopted and established by the director of research of the legislative council appointed pursuant to section C.R.S. §2-3-304(1) in accordance with C.R.S. §24-72-205(6)(b).
- 4. Requests for public records shall only be processed and accessible during reasonable times within the hours when the County of Otero's Clerk and Recorder's Office is open.
- 5. All requests for copies of public records shall be charged \$0.25 per letter size page, and an additional fee for legal sized paper.
- 6. All requests for electronic copies shall include a fee for the actual cost of the electronic storage device (thumb drive, disk, etc.).
- 7. Before providing access to public records, or before beginning the research and retrieval process, the County of Otero shall require an advance deposit fee; to include the time it is projected to take to identify and segregate records that need to be disclosed.
- 8. If the request for public records requires the assistance of an outside entity to access the public records, the requestor of the public records shall pay the actual cost of the third-party services.
