- This includes participating in community systems building initiatives, reducing duplication of services, and eliminating fragmented services to families.
- The position also facilitates Individualized Services and Support Team (ISST) family meetings and assists in the development of an action plan.
- In addition, the coordinator is responsible for facilitating Interagency Oversight Group (IOG) meetings and enhancing the degree of collaboration between stakeholders in the judicial district.
- Bachelor's degree from four-year college or university with major course work preferably in Management and/or the Social Sciences.
- Experience in management and/or in social sciences may be substituted for education requirements.
- Salary range starts at \$3401 and is negotiable depending on experience.
