## CALIBRATING PROBE THERMOMETER

NOTE: Handle thermometer gently. Rough handling or

dropping will cause it to lose calibration.

<u>WHEN:</u> Calibrate each thermometer frequently.

HOW:

- 1. Fill a medium sized glass with ice.
  - Add water to ice.
  - · Place thermometer in glass of ice water.
- 2. Wait 3 minutes.
  - Stir water occasionally.
- 3. After 3 minutes, thermometer should read 32°F.

## **CORRECTIVE ACTION:**

## IF THERMOMETER DOES NOT READ 32°F:

- 1. Leave it in the ice water.
- 2. Using pliers or an adjustable wrench, turn adjustable nut on back of thermometer until needle reads 32°F.
  - It may be necessary to add more ice.
- 3. Wait 3 minutes, stir occasionally.
- 4. After 3 minutes, thermometer should read 32°F.
  - · If not, repeat corrective action.
