On October 24, 2022, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Otero voted in an open meeting after public notice to decline participation in FAMLl. The County of Otero has officially submitted the required written notice.

In accordance with Section 8-13.514 C.R.S., you have the right to opt into the FAMLl health program by April 22, 2023 (180 calendar days from the day of the vote), should you choose to elect and pay for this coverage.
